#### Sunday Services at St. James, Farmington



#### **Contemporary Collects and Prayers**


- **March 3 3 Lent -** Almighty God, you know that we have no power in ourselves to help ourselves: Keep us both outwardly in our bodies and inwardly in our souls, that we may be defended from all adversities which may happen to the body, and from all evil thoughts which may assault and hurt the soul; through Jesus Christ our Lord, who lives and reigns with you and the Holy Spirit, one God, for ever and ever. *Amen*.
- **March 10 4 Lent -** Gracious Father, whose blessed Son Jesus Christ came down from heaven to be the true bread which gives life to the world: Evermore give us this bread, that he may live in us, and we in him; who lives and reigns with you and the Holy Spirit, one God, now and for ever. *Amen*.
- **March 17 5 Lent -** Almighty God, you alone can bring into order the unruly wills and affections of sinners: Grant your people grace to love what you command and desire what you promise; that, among the swift and varied changes of the world, our hearts may surely there be fixed where true joys are to be found; through Jesus Christ our Lord, who lives and reigns with you and the Holy Spirit, one God, now and for ever. *Amen*.
- **March 24 Palm Sunday -** Almighty and everliving God, in your tender love for the human race you sent your Son our Savior Jesus Christ to take upon him our nature, and to suffer death upon the cross, giving us the example of his great humility: Mercifully grant that we may walk in the way of his suffering, and also share in his resurrection; through Jesus Christ our Lord, who lives and reigns with you and the Holy Spirit, one God, for ever and ever. *Amen*.
- **March 28 Maundy Thursday -** Almighty Father, whose dear Son, on the night before he suffered, instituted the Sacrament of his Body and Blood: Mercifully grant that we may receive it thankfully in remembrance of Jesus Christ our Lord, who in these holy mysteries gives us a pledge of eternal life; and who now lives and reigns with you and the Holy Spirit, one God, for ever and ever. *Amen*.
- **March 29 Good Friday -** Almighty God, we pray you graciously to behold this your family, for whom our Lord Jesus Christ was willing to be betrayed, and given into the hands of sinners, and to suffer death upon the cross; who now lives and reigns with you and the Holy Spirit, one God, for ever and ever. *Amen*.
- **March 31 Easter Sunday -** Almighty God, who through your only-begotten Son Jesus Christ overcame death and opened to us the gate of everlasting life: Grant that we, who celebrate with joy the day of the Lord's resurrection, may be raised from the death of sin by your life-giving Spirit; through Jesus Christ our Lord, who lives and reigns with you and the Holy Spirit, one God, now and for ever. *Amen*.

Greetings from the desk of your parish clerk who is wondering what to write..... It is an in-between time of year. Winter is hanging on with cold temperatures, and the possibility of snow still very real. It is the season of Lent, a quiet time of prayer, contemplating our faith and recognizing the sacrifice Jesus made for us. Yet, on the horizon are Easter and the celebration of Jesus' resurrection. Spring will be popping out in warm sunlight and green buds on the trees.

St. Mark's has been busy during this "quiet time". We had our Annual Meeting and elected our "new" vestry, all familiar faces. Thank you to all for agreeing to serve in our last year as "St. Mark's". Our merger committees have been meeting to sort the details of by-Laws, financial accounts, property and mission work of both St. Mark's and St. James parishes.

Here's what to expect during the coming weeks:

- 1. We will continue to worship in Erwin Chapel with supply priests or our worship leader, Stephen Hard. Holy Week and Easter will be at St. James. We had hoped to have our final service as St. Mark's in Erwin Chapel with Mother Pat Hames on Pentecost Sunday. This has been postponed until Mother Hames is available.
- 2. We need to choose a new name! We had some discussion about it at our Annual Meeting. One of the suggestions was "St. James Episcopal Church, Farmington, with St. Mark's Ministries, New Britain". Let's talk about it! Give your ideas to the vestry or Cheryl. Both parishes will have a vote.
- 3. We will have a Parish Meeting to officially vote to "merge". We hope to do this before summer so all necessary details may be settled with the diocese ahead of the final approval vote at the CT Annual Convention on Oct. 26, 2024.

As time goes on, we will find out more steps to follow, so stay tuned for updates.

## Thursday, March 28 - Maundy Thursday - Time TBA St. James, Farmington

MAUNDY THURSDAY gets its name from 'mandatum' meaning commandment – the commandment to the disciples and to us, to 'love one another' as Jesus loves. This commandment came within the setting of the Last Supper and so on this day we recall the institution of the Holy Eucharist as we break bread together for the last time before we celebrate the risen Christ. Jesus himself enacted the commandment to love by washing the disciples' feet and in our liturgy we are given the opportunity to do likewise and wash one another's feet as a sign of the ways we serve one another as Christ served us. Following the Eucharist the altar is stripped as we remember how Jesus goes from the upper room to the Garden awaiting his trial and arrest.
